

On Wednesday morning we heard of the death in Brisbane of Clifford James Buffett, formerly of Steele's Point, Norfolk Island, only son of the late Claude and Beattie Buffett also of Steele's Point.

Cliff was born on 24th August 1919 at Grenfell, NSW, but went to school on Norfolk and at the age of 17 went to sea, starting as a launch boy on the Burns Philp ship, s.s."Morinda".

He worked his way up to obtaining his Captain's Certificate and during the war years served in the Merchant Navy, carrying and evacuating troops.

Practically his whole life was spent at sea,

sailing to all parts of the globe.

On his retirement he returned to Norfolk with his wife Jess and family and built their home at Steele's Point. However, he was often called upon to relieve and during their years on Norfolk went to sea many times.

Cliff is survived by his daughter Julie and two

sons, Paul and Daryl.

Cliff was very popular with his fellow seamen. We always were cheered by his presence when he called on us in the Printery from time to time. He was brother to Maude Buffett of Cascades and a great favourite with Maude's family - her husband "Hackett" and their family of Allan, (Kissard), John (Beef) and Elaine.
