It was with great sadness that we learned of the death in St. George Hospital, Sydney on Thursday, 21st April, 1992 of Bruce Colin Mackenzie former long-time resident of Norfolk Island and one who gave many years of service to the community on the Council and in the Legislative Assembly.

Bruce was the eldest son of the late Noel and Linda Mackenzie of Melbourne. He came to Norfolk just on 30 years ago and was an electrician by trade. He was born 29th December 1936. He had a battle with cancer for the last few vears.

He served on the Norfolk Island Council during the years 1970 to 78 and then on the Legislative Assembly up until 1982.

He then became in charge of the electricity undertaking, leaving Norfolk sometime in

1989. He held down a good position in Sydney, travelling to New Guinea for his firm at times.

He was a "straight shooter" and a very popular young man on the island. Dedicated to keeping Norfolk as is. He was always on hand to give a helping hand. Never a school concert went by that Bruce was not there to organise the lighting for that and for other functions, cheerfully working and always making sure that I was given sufficient lighting for my piano! A remark from one his many friends on the island says something for the regard we had for Bruce - "he was a Top Lad"!

Father of young Race, Bruce has two brothers Alan - wife Helen - and Ross - wife Heather and son Hywel. Helen, Ross and Hywel are living in

England.

Arrangements are being made to bring Bruce back to Norfolk for burial and a graveside service will be announced over VL-2-NI when those arrangements have been finalised.
