With approximately 460 passengers on board. The *Seabourn Odyssey* is a Mega Yacht at 198M in length and part of the Seaborne Cruise Line Ltd that have 6 cruise ships in their fleet, she is on a 22- day adventure having left Tahiti on 27th October her voyage will finish in Sydney on 2 December.

With approximately 260 passengers on board this voyage is in collaboration with National Geographic expeditions it's an 11 day cruise starting in Noumea and finishing in New Zealand on 2nd December.
