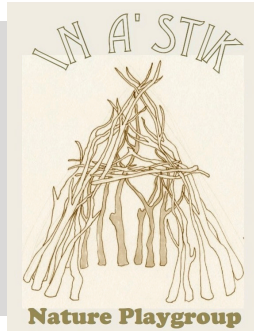
Goodbye Frankie was released in February on Spotify, iTunes/Apple Music, Google Play, Amazon and CD.
